Project description: Possible housing solutions include: repairs, renovations, new home construction, latrine construction, use of low cost technology in building (ISSB) Interlocking Stabilized Soil Blocks. Possible volunteer tasks include: fixing doors & windows, plastering, floor slab construction, painting, putting up walls, foundation excavation, making timber trusses, ISSB block making.

Why we build: HFHK aims to improve the housing conditions for vulnerable groups which include: elderly, PLWD (People Living With Disability), orphans and vulnerable children, and widows/ female heads of household in the community.

The population of Orphans and Vulnerable Children (OVC) in Kenya is estimated to be 2.6 million and is set to increase. This is a result of the HIV/AIDS crisis where more than 1,000 people die daily due to HIV/AIDS in Kenya.
