

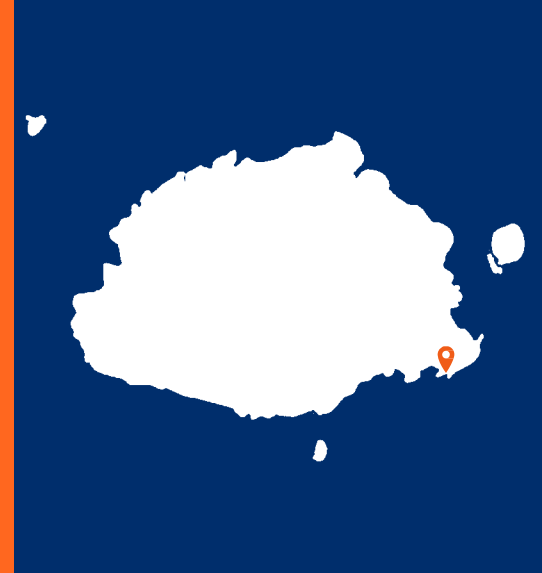
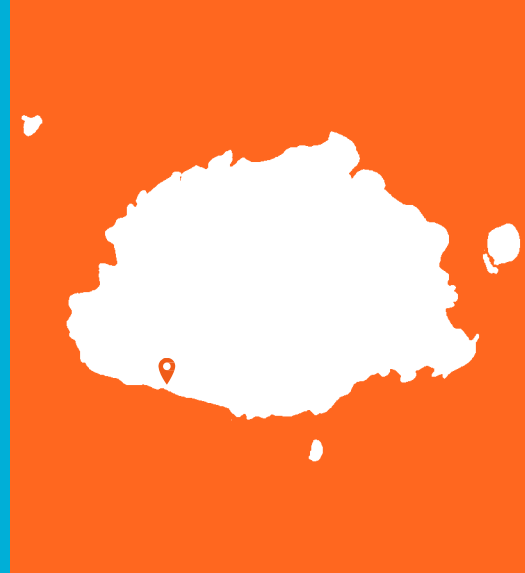
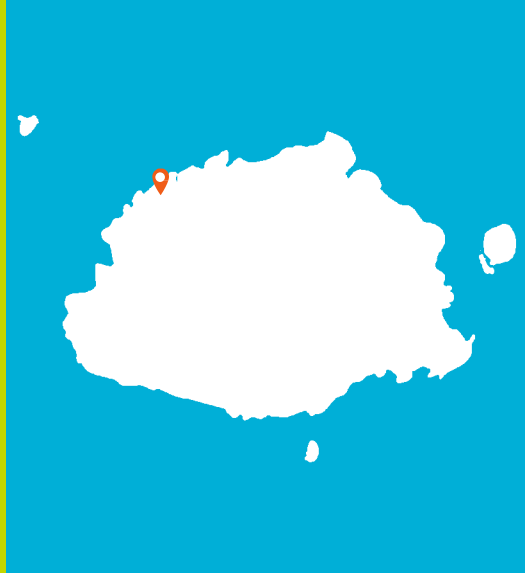

Nadi

Project Description: Volunteers will build under the Beneficiary-Based Approach with Habitat for Humanity Fiji, working alongside future homeowners to ensure each house meets the needs of a family and fosters a strong sense of ownership and community.

What to expect: Volunteers arrive at Nadi International Airport and are taken to the chosen accommodation. Teams travel 20 - 30 minutes daily to the project site, either formal or informal settlements.

Lautoka

Suva

Project Description: Volunteers will be supporting a project led by Habitat for Humanity Fiji in partnership with the Fiji Housing Assistance and Relief Trust (HART) to retrofit existing homes, transforming them into safe, accessible and comfortable living spaces for the elderly.

What to expect: Volunteers arrive at Nadi International Airport, transit through to Suva International Airport and are taken to the chosen accommodation. Teams travel 20 - 30 minutes daily to the project site, either formal or informal settlements.
