Eric Draut of Chicago has been a member of the Thrivent Board of Directors since February 2015. He currently serves on the Audit committee.

Draut began his career as an audit manager at Coopers & Lybrand (now part of PricewaterhouseCoopers). He spent 20 years with Unitrin (now Kemper Corp.), a financial services holding company, a tenure that included 13 years as executive vice president and CFO. Over that period, he also managed a \$6 billion investment portfolio and led numerous acquisition, divestiture and financing transactions.

Draut earned a bachelor's degree in accountancy with high honors from the University of Illinois and also holds an MBA from the J.L. Kellogg School of Management at Northwestern University. He is a CPA and a National Association of Corporate Directors Fellow.

Draut currently serves on the board of TCP Capital, and as interim chief executive officer and a board member at Holy Family Ministries. His past board service includes terms at Intermed, Unitrin, Journeys from PADS to HOPE—a coalition of homeless shelters—and Lutheran Social Services of Illinois, where he was named Chairman Emeritus and previously served as Executive Chair. In recognition of those and other efforts, he was awarded the Call to Service Award by the President's Council on Service and Civic Participation.
