Ken Carow of Greenwood, Indiana, was elected to Thrivent Financial's Board of Directors in February 2013. He serves on the audit and the Thrivent Financial Committees. Ken is a professor of finance and currently serves as the executive associate dean of faculty and research at Indiana University's Kelley School of Business Indianapolis (KSBI).
