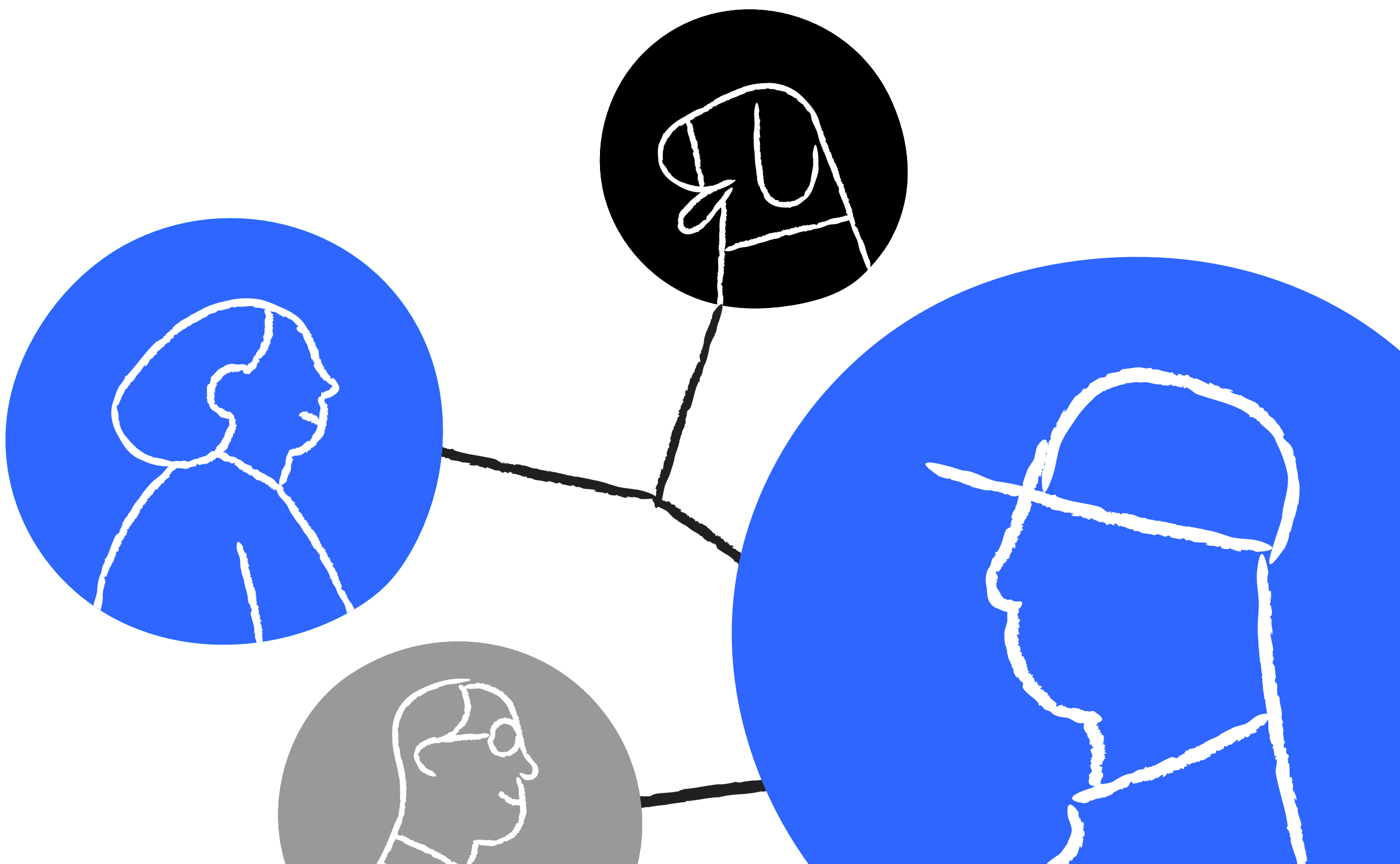




# Flip the Script Conversation Starters
