



ORGANIZATION ELIGIBILITY

In order to receive Choice Dollars® grant funding, each organization must:

- Be an incorporated, nonprofit organization that is exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
- Be domiciled in the U.S. and providing services.
- Be able to receive Choice Dollars grant funds through electronic funds transfer (EFT).
- Agree and comply with the Thrivent Choice® Terms and Conditions for Organizations and any changes to these Terms and Conditions. Terms and Conditions can be found in the Thrivent Choice reference center.

Application process

- A Thrivent Financial benefit member¹ must nominate an organization before it is invited to apply for enrollment as a Choice Dollars grant funds recipient organization. Meeting the above criteria does not guarantee that an organization will be approved for participation.
- Eligible organizations will be sent an online Thrivent Choice Charitable Organization Application that they will need to complete and submit to Thrivent Financial if they wish to be considered as a Choice Dollars grant funds recipient organization.
- Thrivent Member Network leadership boards review and approve or deny organizations based on the eligibility criteria and approval policies for Choice Dollars grant funding.
- Thrivent Financial reviews the decisions made by the Thrivent Member Network leadership boards and notifies the organizations of the enrollment decision.

Terms and Conditions

Receiving grant funds from the Thrivent Choice program is subject to the Terms and Conditions of the Thrivent Choice program. Organizations wanting to enroll in Choice Dollars must read and agree to the Thrivent Choice Terms and Conditions for Organizations prior to submitting the enrollment application. ¹A benefit member is someone 16 years or older who meets membership eligibility, has been admitted for membership, and has a qualified connection to a Thrivent Financial insurance or annuity product or has received a settlement agreement from such insurance.
