

HFH Maui | Maui County, HI



Leaving devastation in their wake, a series of wildfires ignited on the island of Maui in early August 2023. Historic Lahaina suffered the greatest loss with more than 2,200 structures damaged or destroyed, over 100 lives tragically lost, and thousands of residents displaced. Among the losses were 10 Habitat for Humanity Maui homes.

Entire neighborhoods were reduced to ashes in a single night. Yet even in the face of destruction, the spirit of Maui remains unshakable. Habitat for Humanity Maui is standing shoulder to shoulder with the community by providing gap funding, reconstruction, and repairs to ensure rebuilding is not just possible, but affordable and accessible.

We invite you to be part of this story of courage and renewal. Together, we will help rebuild homes, restore communities, and reawaken hope.

Program description

When you join this build, you will work alongside Habitat for Humanity Maui to build homes, community, and hope with their new construction team, local volunteers, and other supporters.

Depending on the stage of the home, volunteers can expect to:

- Form foundations
- Frame and raise walls
- Install windows, doors, and siding
- Paint siding and the home interior
- Lay flooring
- Install interior doors and trim
- Assemble cabinets
- Build fences and sheds
- Landscape

Off the work site, you will have the opportunity to explore the local area including local parks, markets, and other activities your team leader arranges.

Lodging and meals

You will stay at a local hotel. Meals will vary slightly from day to day. Breakfast will be provided. The affiliate will provide lunch on build days. Dinner will be at local restaurants. We are fully prepared to adjust meals for dietary restrictions.

Itinerary

Monday: Arrive. Arrive at Kahului Airport (OGG) by 4pm. Meet the team at the airport and head to the hotel. Check into the hotel and enjoy your first team dinner.

Tuesday: Welcome & Orientation. Meet the HFH Maui staff for orientation and spend the afternoon doing team activities.

Wednesday-Friday: Build. Spend the day on the build site, breaking for lunch, snacks and water. You'll have free time and team activities in the evenings. On Friday enjoy an "ohana" lunch with Habitat Maui friends and families.

Saturday: Build & Explore. Spend the morning on the build site with lunch on your own and the afternoon open for team activities.

Sunday: Goodbyes. Continue your journey independently or depart for home.
