

# San Gabriel Valley HFH | Altadena, CA



Devastating parts of Los Angeles County, California, in January 2025, the Eaton Fire left tens of thousands displaced. At least 9,000 structures were destroyed including single-family and multi-generational homes – many uninsured, underinsured, or living on limited income, making recovery seem impossible.

Since then, San Gabriel Valley Habitat for Humanity has led the long-term recovery efforts. Bringing the local community and its supporters together, they are rebuilding not just homes, but hope. In October 2025, SGV Habitat began construction on their first rebuild in the Eaton Fire burn scar, and by early 2026 the family was welcomed back home. With community support, they're committed to rebuilding 100 homes in Altadena — and are working to raise funds for more.

Join the effort to rebuild homes and hope in Southern California, as the community comes together to show their resilience and proudly declare, they are Altadena strong.

### Program description

When you join this build, you will work alongside San Gabriel Valley Habitat for Humanity to build homes, community, and hope with their new construction team, local volunteers, and other supporters. Depending on the stage of the home, volunteers can expect to:

- Frame and raise walls
- Install windows, doors, and siding
- Paint siding and the home interior
- Lay flooring
- Install interior doors and trim
- Assemble cabinets
- Finish work
- Landscape

Off the work site, you will have the opportunity to explore the local area including local parks, markets, and other activities your team leader arranges.

### Lodging and meals

You will stay at a local hotel. Meals will vary slightly from day to day. Breakfast will be provided at the hotel. The affiliate will provide lunch on build days. Dinner will be at local restaurants. We are fully prepared to adjust meals for dietary restrictions.

### Itinerary

**Sunday: Arrive.** Arrive at Hollywood Burbank Airport (BUR) by 4pm. Meet the team at the airport. Check into the hotel and enjoy your first team dinner.

**Monday: Welcome.** Meet the San Gabriel Valley HFH team for orientation and explore the area with your team.

**Tuesday-Friday: Build.** Spend the day on the build site, breaking for lunch, snacks and water. You'll have free time, team activities, and team dinners in the evenings.

**Saturday: Goodbyes.** Continue your journey independently or depart for home.
